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IRB Fee Structure

In order to meet the growing costs associated with the review of research involving human subjects the ASU IRB will begin charging a fee for all protocols funded by private industry sponsors beginning on May 1, 2009. At this time there will be no charge for research funded from other sources or for unfunded research.

The fee is not based on whether the project is actually initiated, but rather on the fact that the project received Full Board or expedited/exempt review. The fee is paid up-front at the time of protocol submission and covers the initial and subsequent review of amendments and adverse event reports during the 12 month period of approval. We are pleased to announce that under an affiliation agreement Investigators conducting Industry Sponsored, Multi-site, Clinical Investigations or Clinical Trials may submit their projects for review by the Western Institutional Review Board (WIRB).

Projects eligible for submission to Western Institutional Review Board must meet any of the following criteria: Clinical Trials, Industry Sponsored Research and Multi-site research programs.

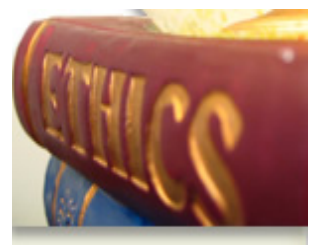
Projects submitted to the Western Institutional Review Board (WIRB) will first receive an ASU "local context" review.
